BUDGET PROPOSITION – 2016-2017

RESOLVED, that the proposed budget of expenditures of the District for the 2016-2017 school year in the amount of \$19,081,276 and for the purposes shown in the statement of estimated expenditures adopted by the Board of Education, be and the same hereby is approved and the amount thereof shall be raised by a levy of a tax upon the taxable property of the school district, after first deducting the monies available from state aid and other sources as provided by law.

PROPOSITION I – LEASE OF SCHOOL BUSES

RESOLVED, that the Board of Education of the Unadilla Valley Central School District be, and hereby is, authorized to enter into a five (5) year lease for four (4) school buses at an annual cost not to exceed \$80,000.00 for each of the five (5) years, beginning in the 2016-2017 school year, to be funded by budgetary appropriation.

PROPOSITION II – CAPITAL RESERVE FUND

Shall the Board of Education be authorized to establish a new twenty-year capital reserve fund pursuant to section 3651(1) of the Education Law in the ultimate amount of \$5,000,000 to be used to fund, in whole or in part, the acquisition of equipment and the construction of renovations, improvements and additions to District buildings and grounds, such reserve fund to be funded from (i) the unexpended balance in the District's current capital reserve fund, which fund will be terminated if this proposition passes, (ii) any non-appropriated General Fund balances for the fiscal year ended June 30, 2016 and each year thereafter, (iii) State aid related to expenditures from the capital reserve fund, (iv) interest income related to investments of money in the fund, (v) incentive aid and (vi) any other monies hereafter authorized by the District voters.

YES 193**NO 42****PROPOSITION III – LIBRARY FUNDING – SOUTH NEW BERLIN FREE LIBRARY**

Shall the appropriation for the South New Berlin Free Library within the Unadilla Valley Central School District be increased by the sum of \$7,825 per year so that the total appropriation to the South New Berlin Free Library shall be \$48,545, which shall be raised by a tax upon the taxable property of the School District in accordance with Education Law section 259.
