BUDGET PROPOSITION - 2014-2015

*RESOLVED, that the proposed budget of expenditures of the District for the 2014-2015 school year in the amount of **\$21,037,359** and for the purposes shown in the statement of estimated expenditures adopted by the Board of Education, be and the same hereby is approved and the amount thereof shall be raised by a levy of a tax upon the taxable property of the district, after first deducting the monies available from state aid and other sources as provided by law.*

PROPOSITION I - Lease of School Buses

RESOLVED, that the Board of Education of the Unadilla Valley Central School be, and hereby is authorized to enter into a five (5) year lease for five (5) school buses at a maximum estimated total annual cost not to exceed \$75,000 for each of the five (5) years, beginning in the 2014-2015 school year and to pay the local share of the cost of the annual lease payment (which is estimated to be \$37,500) from the Capital Reserve Fund established by the voters of the school district on April 9, 1997 to fund capital improvements and the acquisition of equipment.

Richard Potter, Victoria L. Gregory and Kimberly Murray will hold three-year terms, effective July 1, 2014 through June 30, 2017.

PROPOSITION III - Library Funding - New Berlin Library

Shall the appropriation for the New Berlin Library within the Unadilla Valley Central School District be increased by the sum of \$4,000 per year so that the total appropriation to the New Berlin Library shall be \$69,000, which shall be raised by a tax upon the taxable property of the School District in accordance with Education Law section 259.

PROPOSITION IV - Library Funding - South New Berlin Free Library

Shall the appropriation for the South New Berlin Free Library within the Unadilla Valley Central School District be increased by the sum of \$2,495 per year so that the total appropriation to the South New Berlin Free Library shall be \$40,720, which shall be raised by a tax upon the taxable property of the School District in accordance with Education Law section 259.
