7120 – Non-resident students (for 2014-2015 as a trial basis)

Non-resident staff members who wish to enroll children in Unadilla Valley Central Schools must submit a written request to the Superintendent of Schools or his/her designee by April 1. The Superintendent or his/her designee shall review all applications and determine whether or not the student(s) will be admitted. The Superintendent or his/her designee will also determine which building the student will attend. In deciding whether to accept non-resident students for enrollment, the Superintendent or his/her designee shall consider the following guidelines:

- a) Parents/guardians of non-resident students must work out transfer conditions with home school district;
- b) There must be sufficient space in the appropriate building to accommodate the non-resident student;
- c) No increase in the size of faculty or staff will be necessary to accommodate the non-resident student;
- d) No increase in costs to the District is required;
- e) All rules and regulations in effect for District students will be applicable to non-District students;
- f) A student whose parents intend to become residents of the Unadilla Valley Central School District within sixty (60) days of the beginning of the semester in which the enrollment is sought may enter the school if they can provide bona-fide evidence of their intent (i.e., sales contract, deed, etc.);
- g) A student who moves from the District after completion of the first semester of the year preceding his/her anticipated graduation year may be given permission to remain in the Unadilla Valley Central School District until graduation;
- h) Students of any grade level who move from the Unadilla Valley Central School District during the school year may be given permission to finish the year in which the move occurs;
- i) Foreign students participating in a recognized Student Exchange Program may attend District schools. The administration is authorized to file with the U.S. Immigration and Naturalization Service the forms necessary for such students to obtain a student visa. The District will neither sponsor nor accept for admission students whose permanent residence is outside of the United States who are not participating in a recognized foreign student exchange program; and

- j) Families of non-resident students who are permitted to enroll in Unadilla Valley schools must provide their own transportation. The District shall not be responsible to provide transportation for non-resident students.

Children of non-resident staff members hired since June 1, 2010 who are accepted for enrollment in the Unadilla Valley Central School District for the 2014-2015 school year will not be subject to tuition charges for such school year; tuition charges for future school years shall be subject to continuing review by the Board of Education. Children of staff members hired prior to June 1, 2010 that are accepted as non-resident students can continue to attend without being subject to tuition charges.

The Superintendent or Superintendent's designee may terminate the student's enrollment as a non-resident student if the Superintendent or Superintendent's designee determines that the student has violated the student code of conduct, or is not achieving academically at the student's ability level.
